The Sample The South Burnett sessions will be

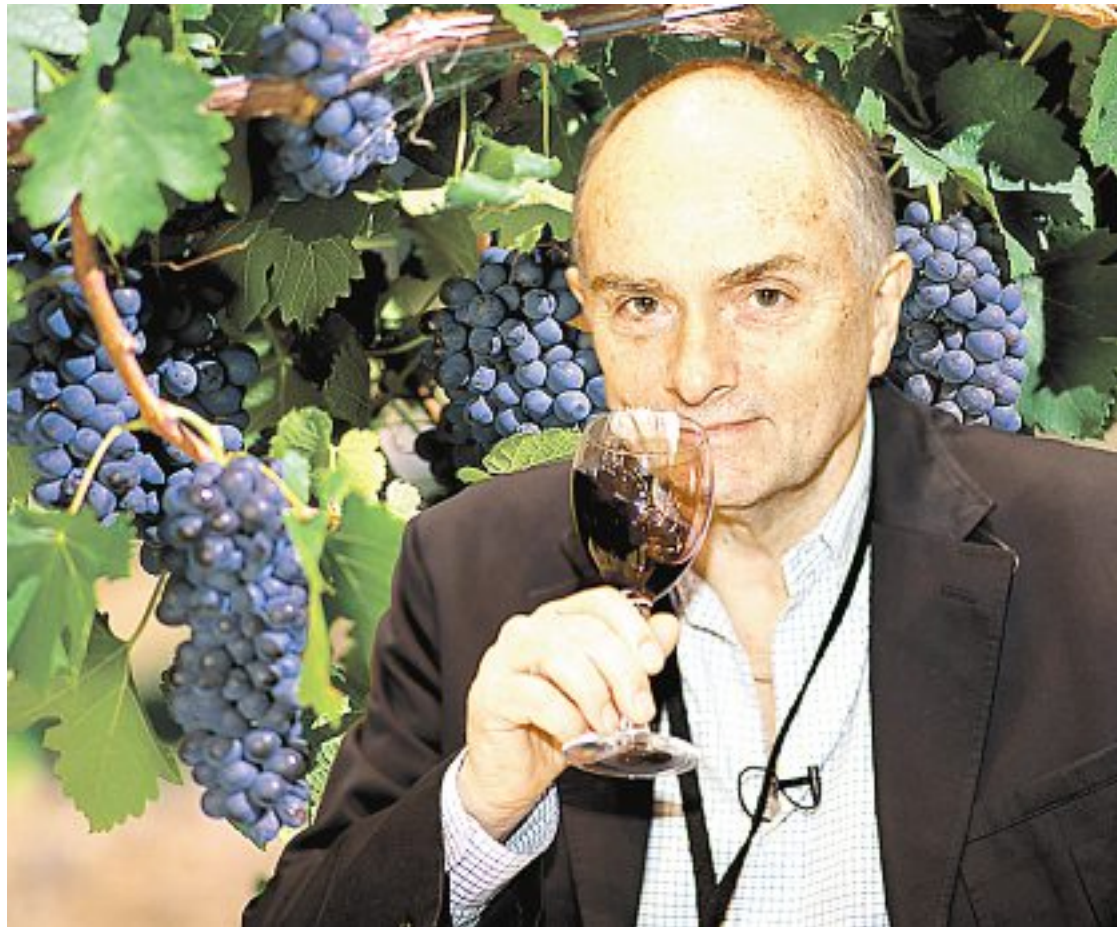
held in the PCA marquee after the Junior Cook-off competition.

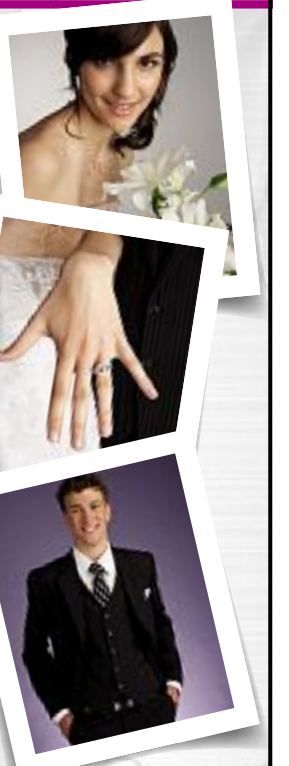
